Since I started teaching here, the other teachers and staff members have been especially nice and helpful, and the students have been fantastic. They behave excellently, and they are usually enthusiastic about learning.

I am currently teaching classes in P.1, P.3, P.4 and P.6. Most of my lessons involve phonics, conversation, reading and reading comprehension. It is very rewarding to see all of the students trying to learn English and making good progress. English is an immeasurably useful language for a student to learn because of how widely spoken it is. I find it highly rewarding to help students in acquiring this useful tool. The language is also beneficial in terms of entertainment; most TV programs and movies are in English, which makes the language rather fun for young students to learn.

Teaching at Lo has taught me a lot as well. I have learned a great amount about teaching in the three months that I have been here. I believe I now have a solid understanding of the strengths and weaknesses of my regular students, and I see that they have very distinct personalities and different interests. I was astounded by some of the performances at the talent show just before the Christmas holiday. Everybody that was involved did brilliantly. One of the main reasons why teaching at LKKB has been enjoyable is that the students appear to enjoy their time here. They have progressed well over the past few months. In my previous teaching job, the students liked the lessons, but we did not see them very regularly throughout the week, so it was harder to notice their progress. I see the students I teach at LKKB more often, so it is easier to build a rapport with them



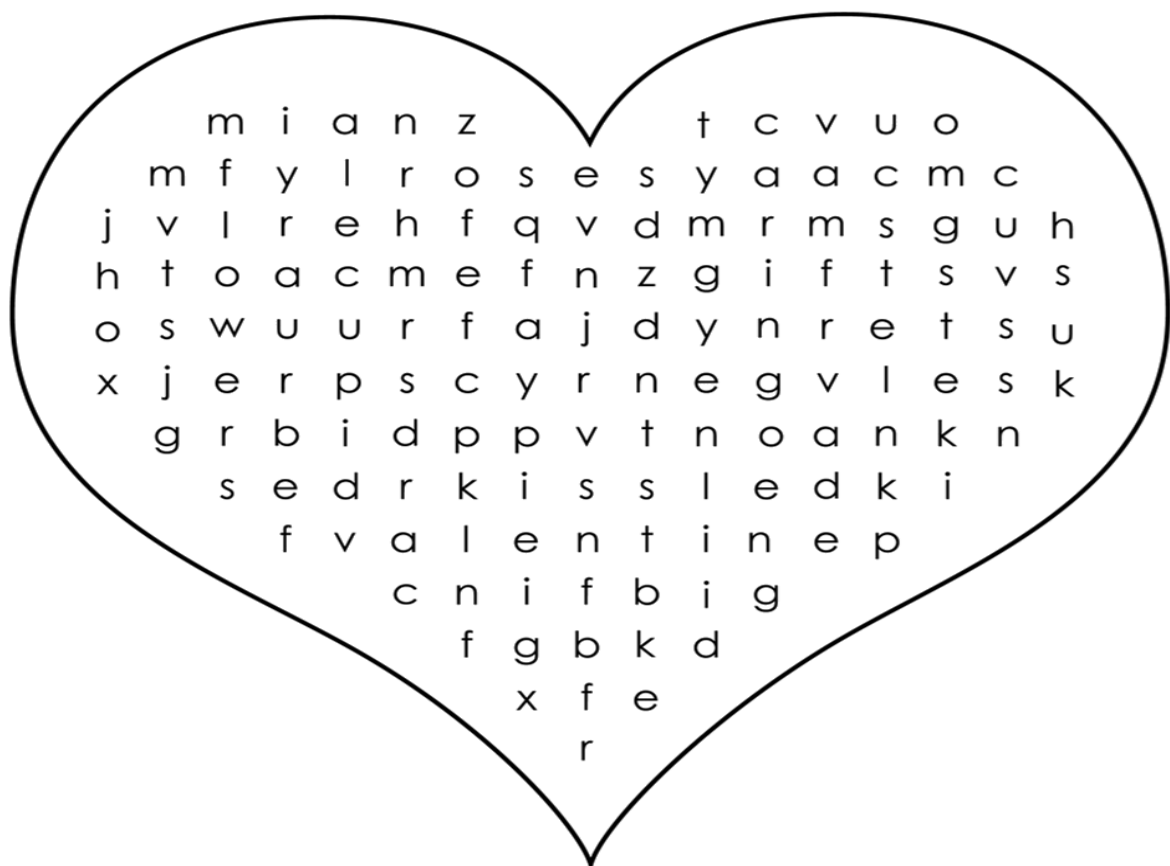
and see the gains they have achieved.

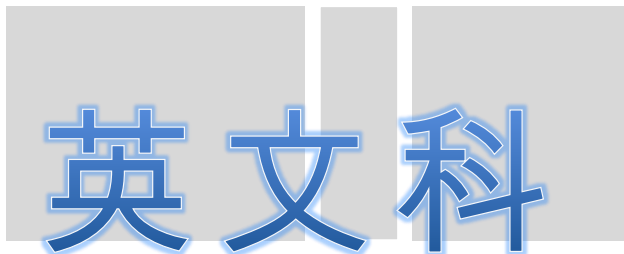
