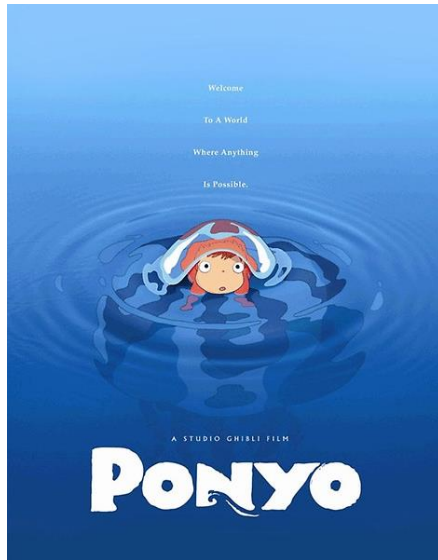

A film I think you must watch is Ponyo (2008). Ponyo is a little goldfish girl who lives with her father, a powerful wizard, in the sea. Have you ever heard of a sport called hurling? It's very popular in Ireland. Let me introduce this exciting sport to you.

Hurling

There are many different kinds of sports. Some sports, such as soccer, rugby and basketball, are played in countries all over the world. There are some sports that are only played in one place. There is a sport called 'hurling' which is highly popular in Ireland. You might find it interesting. A game of hurling is played by two teams with fifteen players. Every player wears a helmet and carries a stick called a 'hurley'. The ball that the game is played with is called a 'sliotar', and it is roughly the same size as a tennis ball, but it is harder and heavier. Hurling is an incredibly fast sport. Each team try to pass the ball to each other with the hurleys (the sticks) and then hit the ball into the goal for three points or over the crossbar for one point. Hurling requires a lot of hand-eye coordination, because the players all need to be able to catch the ball as it moves at very high-speed, strike the ball in the air and balance the ball on the hurley and run with it. Hurling is an ancient sport. Amazingly, it may have been first played 3,000 years ago.



There are hundreds of clubs around Ireland that play hurling, and the best players from these clubs represent their countries in the All-Ireland Hurling Championship. Kilkenny have won 36 championships, which is more than any other countries. Galway, my favourite team, are the current champions.



Hurling is one of the most popular and most-watched sports played in Ireland. The most important games of the year are played in front of 82,000 people in an immense stadium named Croke Park. However, the sport is not professional at any level, meaning that none of the players are paid like in most other sports.



The Liam McCarthy Cup is the name of the trophy that all the countries play for.
