Cup Cake Recipe

Ingredients

| 1. 200g butter | 5. 1/2 teaspoon baking powder |
| 2. 200g caster sugar | 6. 1 teaspoon vanilla essence |
| 3. 200g self-raising flour, sifted | 7. 150g butter |
| 4. 4 eggs | 8. 350g icing sugar, sifted |

Steps

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C.
2. Mix the softened butter and sugar until very light and fluffy with an electric beater or spoon.
3. Add one egg at a time, beating each one in well before adding the next. Then add the vanilla essence in.
4. Put in flour and baking powder. Mix in slowly.
5. Finally put mixture into each cup cake and bake for 10-20 minutes. After 10 minutes, use toothpick to see whether cup cakes are ready. If toothpick comes out dry, then the cupcakes are ready. If not, put it back in the oven.
6. Once ready, leave to cool.

Vanilla butter icing

1. Using an electric beater or spoon, beat the butter until very soft.
2. Slowly add the icing sugar and a few drops of vanilla essence. Then mix into the butter until you have a smooth paste.
3. Then put some vanilla icing on top on the cool cup cakes.

My best Christmas gift was the new clothes because I felt handsome when I wore them. These were my best Christmas gifts.

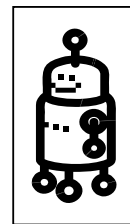


My Christmas

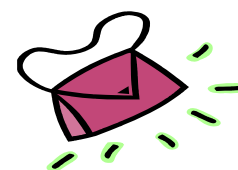

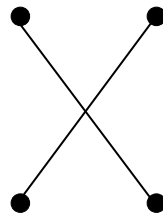
