"Where did you go?" I asked my dad. He was laughing. "I

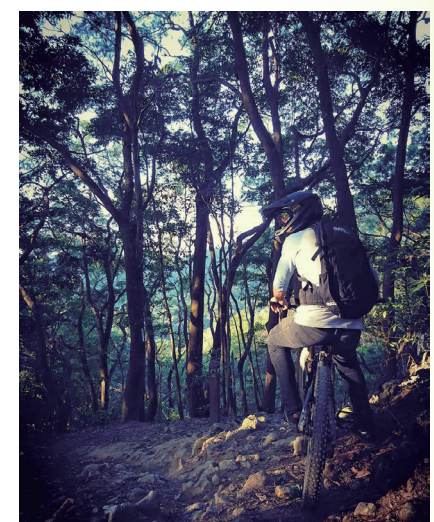
can't always push you. You have to go on your own" he said. "But it's scary" I said. He looked at me and smiled, "It might be scary now, but it will get easier".

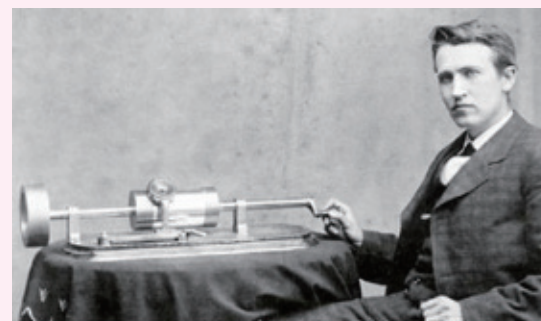
The Scientist I Most Admire

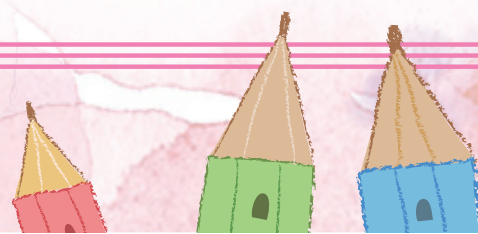
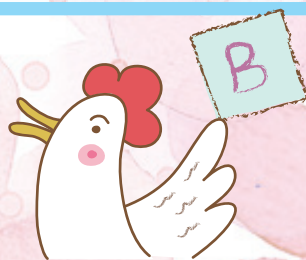
Too Many Computer Games

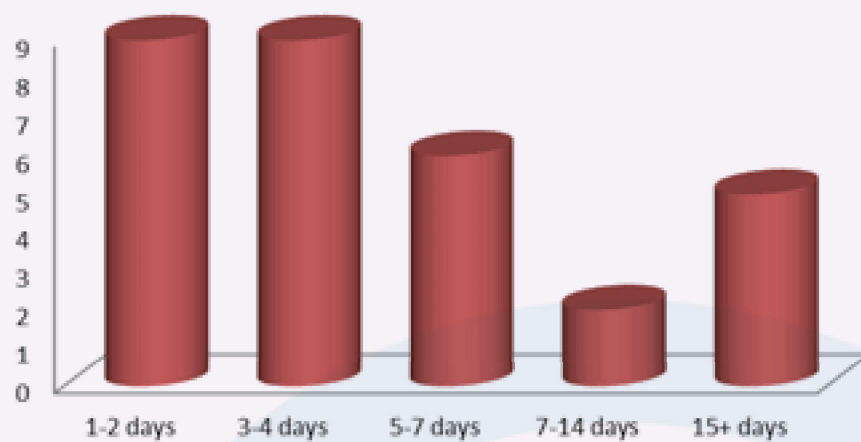

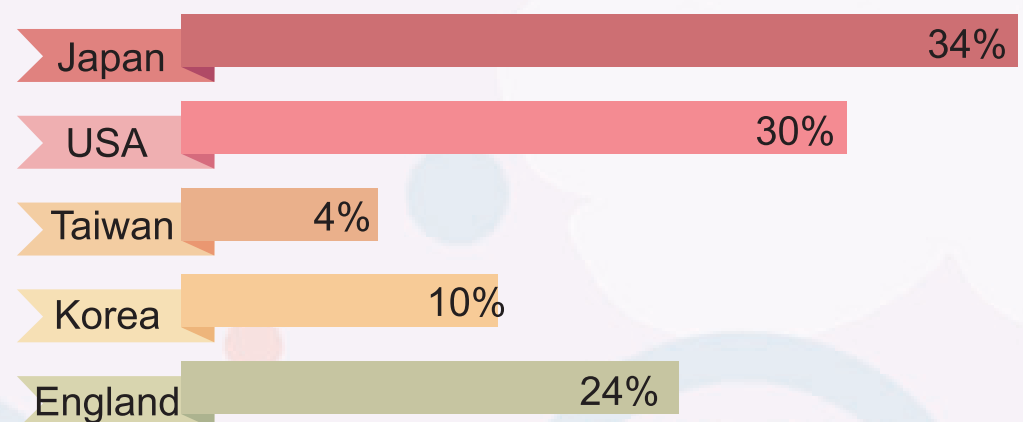
Over three quarters (77%) of students like the holidays. Amazingly, 23% do not like it. We then asked if they travel or have travelled outside of Hong Kong on holiday. 71% of students have travelled abroad.

Next we asked students how many days they go on holiday for. Almost one third (1/3) of students go for 1-2 days, while another third (1/3) go for 3-4 days. Five lucky students (20%) go for 15 days or more! Japan is the most popular country (34%) students would like to visit followed by the USA (30%) and then England (24%). Taiwan is the least popular country to visit (4%).

Which country would you like to go to?

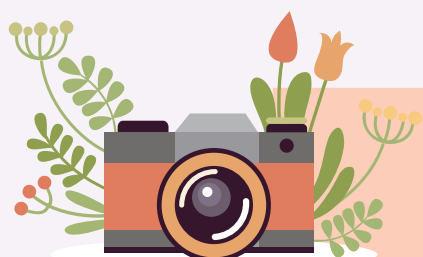


Do you buy souvenirs?
